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Message from the Founder



“Plant wild fruit trees and live a healthy life. Protecting biodiversity is our moral responsibility.”

Chandrakant Ghyar Patil, the founder of Jayawantrao Ghyar Patil Sevabhavi Sanstha (JGPSS), was moved by the poverty, ignorance, and lack of opportunities he saw around him and decided to start his non-profit organization. As a postgraduate in social science (MSW), he decided that he would work to rid his surroundings of these social evils, and he would do this by involving the community in his work.

Based in Hingoli district, Chandrakant Ghyar Patil has worked as a district-level assistant project officer in the Sakshar Bharat 2012 program under the Continuing Education Department. He has also worked as a subject matter expert (SME) in the education campaign.

Chandrakant Ghyar Patil's work has been appreciated and recognized by the government. He is a recipient of the District Level Adarsh Teachers Award, and he has been honored by the Government of Maharashtra twice for his work as Block Coordinator—Hingoli Block—in the Total Sanitation Campaign—Nirmal Gram. His work at the district level has also received recognition.

An erudite and compelling speaker in the Marathi language, his enthusiasm for his work requires him to wear many hats, including driving, typing, working on computers, etc. He is a progressive thinker and has introduced new ideas and technologies in the many areas in which his NGO works.

ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

Vision:

To inspire societal change and build a self-sustained, empowered community through health, organic farming, and skill development.

Jayavantrao Ghyar Patil Sevabhavi Sanstha, located in Hingoli, Maharashtra, was established on 26th January 2007. Chandrakant Ghyar Patil is the founder, trustee, and coordinator of the organization. The organization was established in the name of Jayavantarava Ghyara Patil, who was a great Samaritan known for his commitment towards societal development.

He had a caturhastraha (multi-skilled) personality and was proud of his lineage of farming families in Jayavantarao. Although illiterate himself, he realized the importance of education and would encourage members of the community to send their children to schools. He worked as a carpenter, weaver (creating baskets, tree guards, darale, tatte/tatave, etc. from plant branches), soil worker (matikam), blacksmith, bricklayer, flax/linen, and jute worker. He promoted mental and physical well-being through yoga and regular exercise and was also an animal lover and would treat injured stray dogs and other animals himself.

The vision of this Sanstha is to develop the life spirit of Jayavantrao Ghyar Patil in every citizen, promoting health care, organic farming, culture, skill development of the weaker sections, sustainable development, and contributing in work towards nation-building.

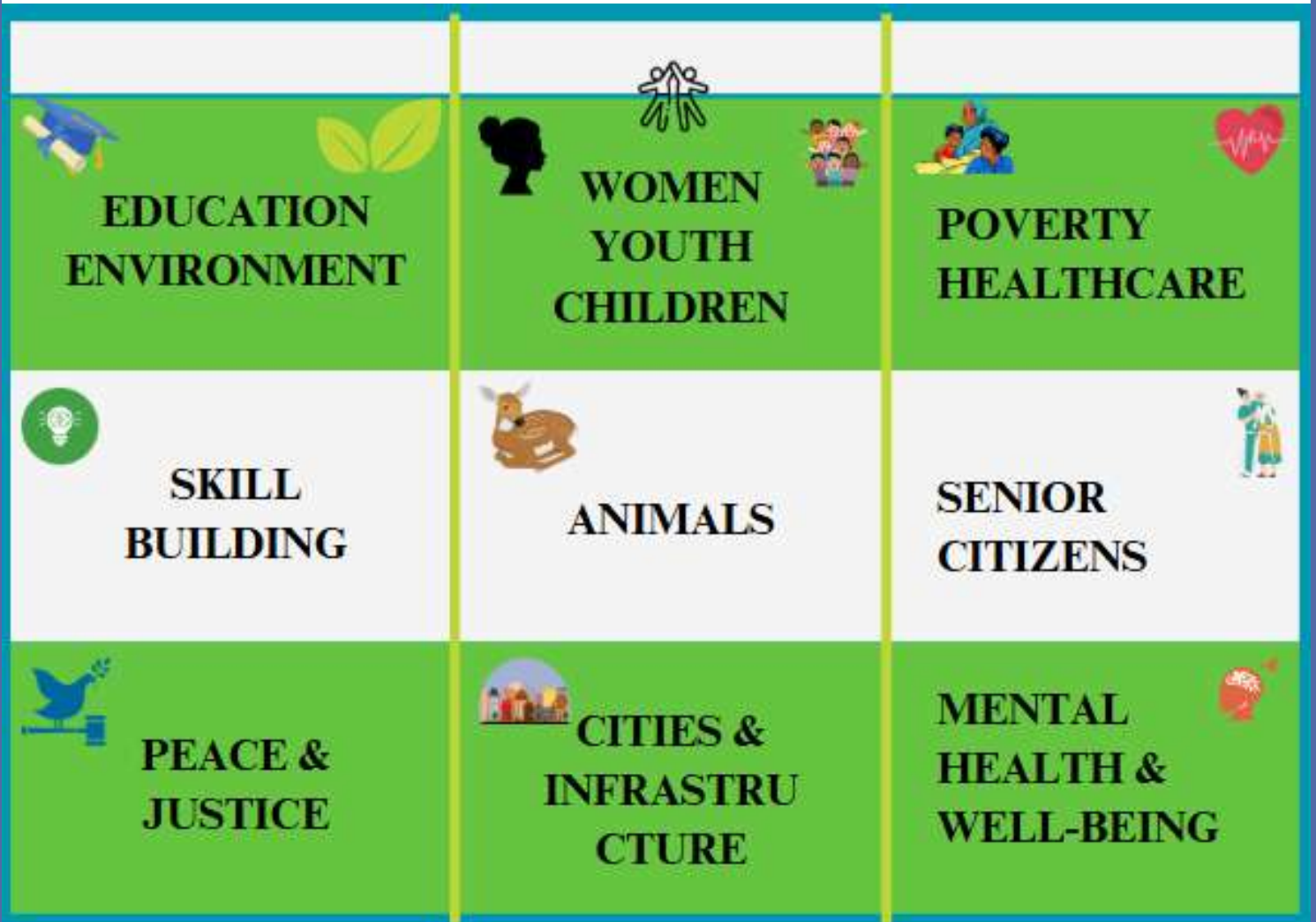

Highlights of FY 2023-24

Participation in the International Science Festival of India – 2023

Millet Mission Awareness Campaign



The importance of millets as a sustainable and nutritious crop has gained significant attention in recent years due to their climate-resilient nature, health benefits, and low environmental footprint. Recognizing this potential, the Jayawantrao Ghyar Patil Sevabhavi Santha (a prominent social organization based in Maharashtra, India) launched an awareness campaign in Hangoli, a village in the state, to promote the cultivation and consumption of millets. The campaign, referred to as the Millet Mission Awareness Campaign, seeks to educate local farmers, agriculturalists, and the community about the multiple benefits of millets and how they can be incorporated into agricultural practices to improve food security, promote sustainable agriculture, and enhance nutritional health.

Sustainable Agriculture Practices Campaign



In line with its mission to promote sustainable development and improve the livelihoods of farmers in rural areas, the Jayawantrao Ghyar Patil Sewabhavi Santha initiated a Sustainable Agriculture Practices Campaign in Hangoli, Maharashtra. Dam Worship and Government Scheme for Farmers at Hadgaon Small Irrigation Lake



In alignment with the innovative program of the Maharashtra Government, a dam worship ceremony was held on the occasion of the removal of the cheeks from the Hadgaon small irrigation lake, situated in Bhingi and Adgaon Shivarat. The Honorable MLA graced the event as the Chief Guest. Tanhajirao Mutkule Patil offered the Shreefal, and highlighted the Maharashtra Government's plan to grant Rs 37,500/- to minority farmers, widows, disabled individuals, and families affected by farmer suicides. Additionally, assistance will be provided to large farmers through public participation in JCB operations.

The government has forecasted below-average rainfall for the year, resulting in a likely decrease in water storage in the dam. Therefore, the MLA encouraged maximum participation in this scheme to ensure farmers benefit. The removal of the cheeks will help increase water storage in the dam, as well as in bore wells and wells in the region. This will also enhance land fertility and reduce the need for chemical fertilizers and pesticides.

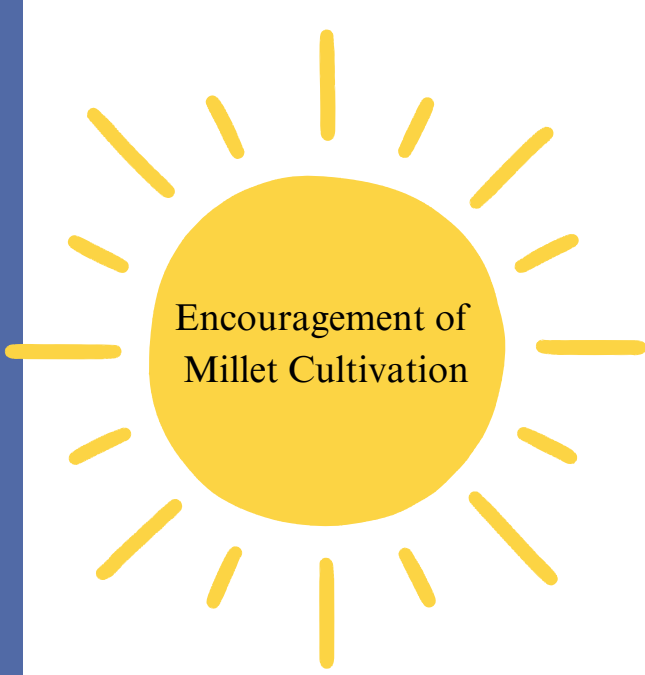

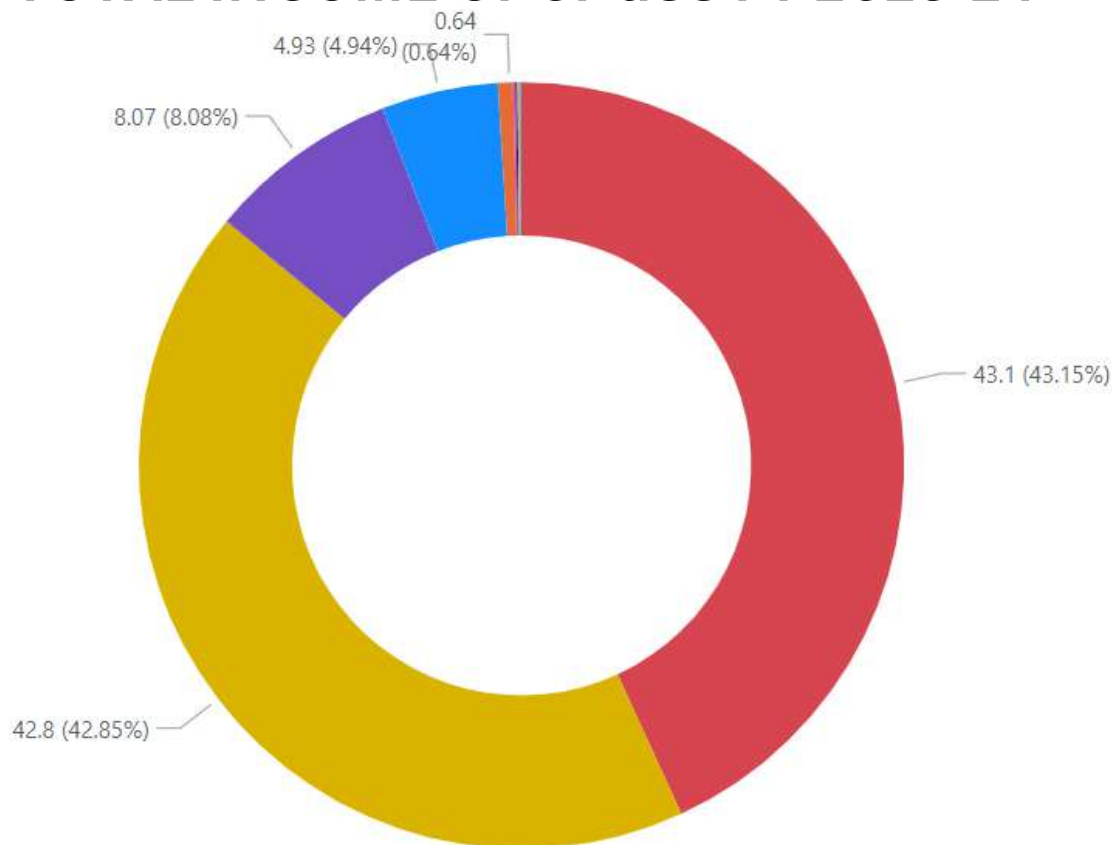

TOTAL INCOME OF JPGSS FY 2023-24



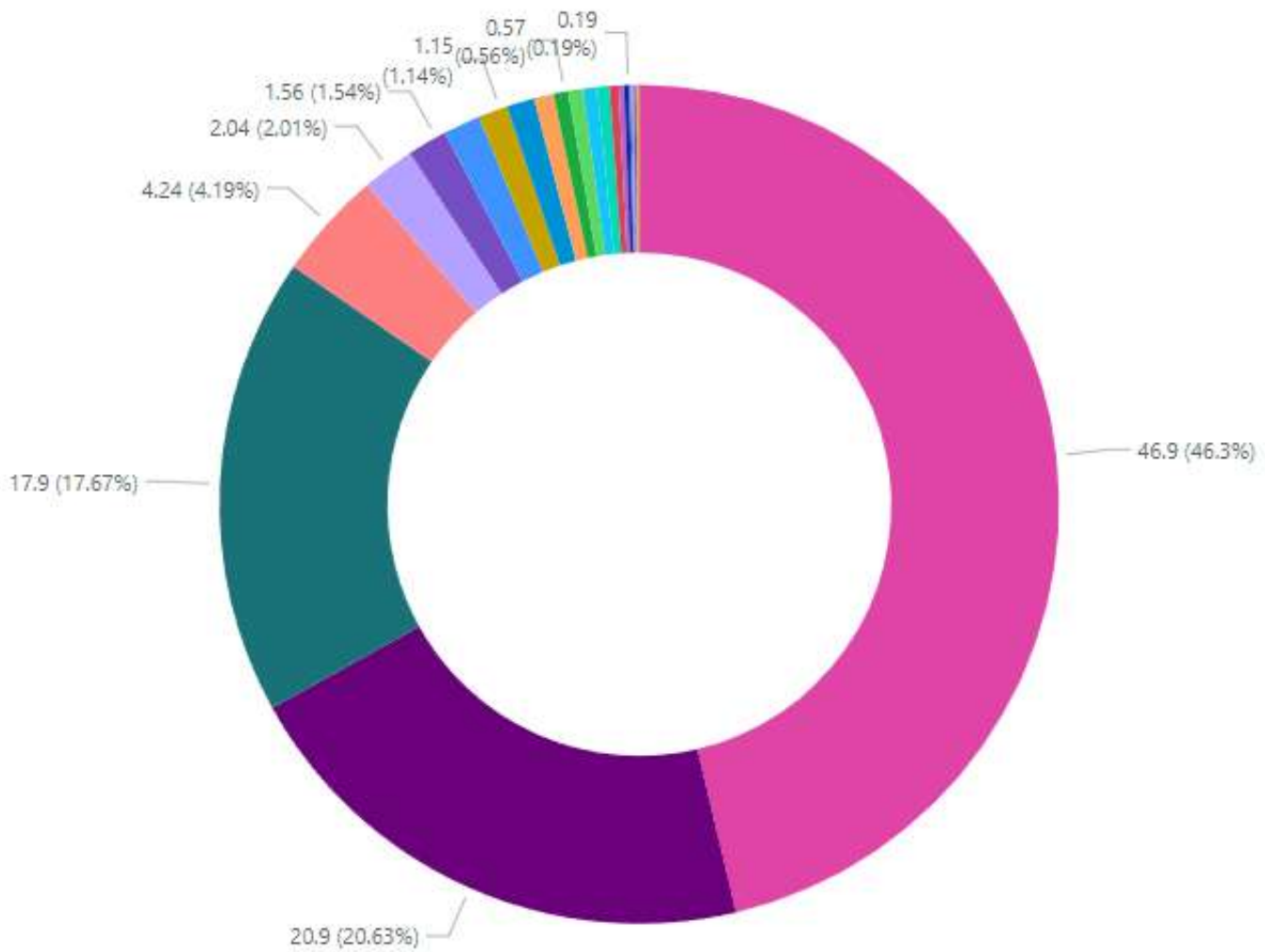
